Excerpts from Terroir Footprints on Ramiiisol vineyards ...

“That first day in the vineyards was enough for me to understand that the place was interesting. In addition, the first wines that I tasted, still very young, had a soul despite being somewhat innocent and of very low production. They had a clear typicity, grip and an emerging, fresh and present minerality on the palate. It was evident that this terroir had something deep and interesting. When observing the property through one, two, three, ten pits, I realized that these were rocky soils based on alterites, that beautiful degradation in sheets or scales that feature some rocks. The soil was orange-red, deep, soft and silty. The terroir I’m referring to is composed by a metamorphic rock called Gneiss.

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I was able to confirm this later, after blindly tasting those wines along with some of the best bottles of Saumur-Champigny that were included without us knowing in one of the flights. I found this tasting alarming. Some wines were exceptional, with pure and beautiful typicities as well as fresh mineralities that are fully up to par with the great ones from the Loire.
